



Schooner *Roseway* Voyage Crew Information

Welcome aboard *Roseway*. As we prepare for the upcoming voyage, we'd like to make sure that everyone is well equipped and prepared.

One of the most important things you need to know as voyage crew is that *Roseway* holds a zero tolerance policy for drugs and alcohol aboard the ship. If any crew member is found to possess or use drugs or alcohol you will be required to leave the ship at the nearest port of call. We are under strict U.S. Coast Guard regulations and deviation from this can jeopardize the entire vessel, crew, and organization. *Roseway* is also a non-smoking vessel.

At times a sailor's life can be cold, wet, and even dirty. Your sense of adventure as well as your willingness to try something new will affect your experience as well as what and how you pack. Depending on your length of stay aboard *Roseway* there are a few things you will need:

- **!!Passport!!**
- Sleeping bag (sheet and pillow are provided)
- Clothing—even if you think you are only sailing in southern waters, you should be prepared for unforeseen weather appropriate to northern climate as cold (or wet) as 30 to 40 degrees. It is recommended you bring long underwear, gloves, and a warm hat.
- Jacket or Raingear—any inexpensive waterproof tops and bottoms and layer clothing to stay warm
- Comfortable (even waterproof) shoes
- Flashlight
- Sea sickness meds (if needed)
- Personal meds: if you are on any essential medication, bring enough for the entire trip and some
- Pocket knife (optional)
- Toiletry kit—you may also want to include handi-wipes, baby powder, or other antibacterial products as freshwater showers are not available while underway.
- Personal Entertainment—Out of every 24 hour period you will stand between 7 and 10 hours of watch. In your 14 to 17 hours of off time you will sleep, eat, work, or otherwise occupy your time. You might want books, magazines, journals, sketch pads, camera, musical instruments, etc. Please keep in mind that at any given time there may be a crew member asleep. Conversations or activities that may prevent sleep should be done on deck with the crew in mind.

As we are a sailing ship unattached to land we do not have an infinite supply of water or electricity. To conserve fresh water there will be no fresh water showers (unless it rains) until we reach a port of destination. Salt water bathing is always acceptable and available! Electricity should only be used when necessary.

Next to the captain, the cook is the most important person on board and should be treated as such. Unless specifically invited, no one should be in the galley while the cook is working unless invited to help. The cook will prepare breakfast, lunch, a mid-afternoon snack, dinner, and an

evening snack. If you have any food allergies or restrictions, please make them known as soon as possible.

Checklist of items to provide to World Ocean School BEFORE departure:

- Completed Application Form (attached)
- Completed Medical Form
- Signed release Form
- Payment

Boarding Times:

You should expect to spend the night before departure on board the vessel. Keep in mind that departure and arrival times vary greatly with weather so you should keep your travel plans flexible on both ends. Please note that drug, alcohol, and smoking regulations apply both in port and at sea. **We will contact you closer to departure to let you know when you need to be on board.**
